Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q. What are your school hours?

Monday through Friday 8:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m. (Students must be present until 11:30 AM in order to be counted as "present" for any school day.)

Q. How many students will you enroll?

A. PLS is capping enrollment for 2021/2022 to 12 students, 4 per grade level.

Q. What grades do you serve?

A. We currently have classrooms for Early Elementary (K-2), Older Elementary (3-6) and Middle/High (7-10).

Q. I have an older teen. Do you offer a high school diploma?

A. We have two options for teens ages 17-22. One is Project Pathlight, a transition-to-work program that includes on-the-job training (OTJ), life skills instruction, social skills and activities of daily living (ADL) skills. Students can enroll in Project Pathlight and also work on their high school diploma or GED with our teachers. We design a customized plan for maximizing independence and community-access for older teens as well as partner with parents for transition planning to college or career.
